Steve Lewis is a 58 year old man who has worked for the US Postal Service for 25 years. At the age of 23, Steve was in a motorcycle accident breaking his neck and leaving him paralyzed from the waist down. For over 33 years, Steve has done his best to keep up with his home and make it work for him and his mobility issues. He has taken on numerous projects throughout the home including renovating his own bathroom so he could move about more easily. Other areas in his home have been gradually deteriorating over the years and he has no resources to make the necessary repairs.

Currently, he lives in the home once owned by his parents and down the street from his Alma Mater, Cypress Lake High School. His home needs widened doorways, minor plumbing repairs, soffit and fascia, wheelchair ramps and a new roof among other items.
